

Terms of Service

Note: Arena's End-User License Agreement (EULA) will be Apple's default (most recently available via https://www.apple.com/legal/internet-services/itunes/dev/stdeula/).

1.0 Overview

Thrivner, Inc. (hereinafter "Thrivner") offers Arena consistent with Apple, Inc.'s (hereinafter "Apple") End-User License Agreement (EULA). These terms of service clarify retentions of rights, disclaimers of warranties and liabilities, and restrictions of app abuses, and is supplemental to Apple's EULA.

2.0 Retention of Rights of Ownership / Ban on Infringement

- **2.1 Ownership.** Users retain all rights and ownership to content. Thrivner does not claim any ownership rights to the content. However, subject to and in accordance with its Privacy Policy, Thrivner has a non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide right to use such content.
- **2.2 License to Your Content.** "Your Content" means any data, content, code, video, images or other materials of any type that users upload, submit, or otherwise transmit to or through Arena. Users will retain all right, title, and interest in and to Your content in the form provided to Arena.
